### **Information We Collect**

We collect information you provide directly while engaging with Jenovate, such as:

Account details: name, email, phone number, and organization details (if applicable).

Course activity: submissions, projects, case study interactions, reviews, and community discussions.

Communication info: messages you send us, along with any attachments.

We also automatically collect certain technical data, including:

Log data: IP address, browser type, device info, referring pages, date/time of access.

Cookies: preferences and activity patterns (you can manage these in your browser settings).

### **How We Use Your Information**

We use your information to operate and improve the Jenovate platform, personalize content and recommendations, develop new features, track learning progress, communicate important updates, send administrative notifications, and detect or prevent fraud or misuse.

### **Sharing of Information**

We do not sell or share your personal information except with trusted service partners or when required by law.

### **Data Retention**

We keep your personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined in this policy, unless required by law.

### **Your Rights**

You may access, update, delete, restrict processing, object to processing, or request a copy of your data.

### **Children's Privacy**

Jenovate is not directed toward children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect their data.
